1.0 Background Information

The Journal of Co-operative and Business Studies (JCBS) is a peer reviewed journal published by the Moshi Co-operative University (MoCU). The journal aims to publish high quality articles from research findings in the field of co-operative and business studies. Specific focus includes but not limited to: Cooperatives, Entrepreneurship, Education, Climate change, Gender, Resource management, Social security, Agribusiness, Marketing, and Economics. The Journal is bi-annually published whereby Issue number two is planned for September 2018. In this regard, the Editorial Board hereby calls for papers on the same for successful take off and the subsequent regular issues.

2.0 Accepted Articles

Submission of an article implies that the work described is original and has not been published previously (except in the form of an abstract or as part of a public lecture, academic thesis/dissertation), or conference proceedings that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere, and that its publication is approved by all authors and tacitly or explicitly by the authorities responsible where the work was carried out. We also accept submissions that have previously appeared on preprint servers (e.g. arXiv, bioRxiv, Nature Proceedings, Philica, Social Science Research Network, and Vixra), have previously been presented at conferences, or have previously appeared in other "non-journal" venues (for example: blogs or posters) provided they are of the required quality.

3.0 Copyright

Copyrights for articles are retained by the authors, with first publication rights granted to the journal. Authors have the rights to archive and distribute their own articles after publication. The journal/publisher is not responsible for subsequent uses of the published article. The publisher and journal have a zero-tolerance plagiarism policy. We check the manuscripts against plagiarism prior to consideration for publication.

4.0 Notes to Contributors

In preparing manuscripts for submission, authors should take note of the following:

- (i) The manuscript, including the reference list, notes and appendices (if any), must be in single space, 12 Font, Times New Roman, margins (of one inch on all four sides), and be set on the standard A4 paper size. Pages must be numbered consecutively at the bottom and in Arabic numbers.
- (ii) Articles submitted for publication must be controlled for plagiarism that will also be verified by the Editor.
- (iii) The article submitted will be reviewed by at least two reviewers.
- (iv) The article must not have been submitted for publication in any other journal.
- (v) The manuscript for research articles should not exceed 8,000 words.
- (vi) For citations, references and bibliography use the APA referencing style.
- (vii) Manuscript text must be in English.
- (viii) Manuscripts in soft copy should be submitted to the Editor through E-mail: chiefeditor_jcbs@mocu.ac.tz
- (ix) **Papers for Issue No. 2 should reach the Editor not later than 5th August 2018**
